Mercurians Model Aeronautical Club (Inc) is a control line club and was formed during the war years in September 1943. The aircraft are flown on wires, and are predominately sports, aerobatics, combat and racing aircraft. Most members compete in club, State, national and International events.

The club operates mainly at the newly established control line facility located off Beechboro Road in Whiteman Park at the Western Australian Model Aircraft Sports Aircraft Centre. Inter club events are also conducted at the TARMAC control line club.
