We look forward to your participation at the 61st MAAA Nationals being held in **Perth, Western Australia** from the **27th December 2007 – January 4th 2008**.

Preparations are well under way to make this a memorable National Championship and the first time that the championships have been held in Perth.

The following information may help you on your arrival and attendance at the 61st MAAA Nationals.

ARRIVAL AND REGISTRATION

Registration and processing of some R/C and C/L models will be undertaken in the marquee tent located at the WA Model Aircraft Sports Centre (Inc) site, Beechboro Road, Whiteman, on Saturday 29th December 2007 from 9am to 5pm.

Free Flight registration and a competitor's goodie bag will available at the Meckering site from 7.30am – 4.30pm on Thursday 27th December 2007. The Free Flight representative Mr Chris Behr can be contacted on mobile 0418 603 865 for further information.

TRANSMITTER TESTING

Transmitter Testing for 36MHZ radio control equipment will be offered **free** at the WA Model Aircraft Sports Centre (Inc) clubroom by an MAAA authorised technician on Saturday 29th December 2007 from 10.00am to 4.00pm. All R/C competitors to have a valid and MAAA approved transmitter.

SAFETY ISSUES

As a fire safety requirement, the WA Model Aircraft Sports Centre (Inc) site will be closed by the local ranger if hot weather conditions become extreme. No mobile telephones are to be used in the pit area at the WA Model Aircraft Sports Centre (Inc). The owner of the farm at Meckering will be providing a fire tender, however we request that competitors and visitors be extremely cautious if smoking, and ensure that cigarettes are extinguished and disposed of appropriately.

CATERING

A number of sites will have catering supplied, however it is advisable for those going to the Meckering Free Flight site, Whiteman Park Free Flight site, Glider site and Wanneroo Aeromodellers (inc) site for competitors and helpers to take their own food and water supplies.

CONTROL LINE HARD STAND – WHITEMAN PARK

Due to the hard stand circle diameter, competitors for some combined speed events are advised to use only 60 foot line lengths.

FIELD AND EVENT CHANGES

Due to the lack of entries, the Free Flight F1H event and all helicopter events will not run. F3A R/C Aerobatics and IMAC will now commence on Saturday 29th December 2007.

Control Line Classic B has moved to the grass site at Swan Christian College and will start at 9.00am on Friday 4th January 2008.

The Glider events have had to change the venue and at this stage the events will be held at the WARS site located at Wordsworth Avenue, Yokine. For further field information, contact Mr Simon Watts on mobile 0414 916 739.
